4 months	Diphtheria-Tetanus-Whooping Cough Hepatitis B Haemophilus Influenzae type b (Hib) Polio Pneumococcal disease
6 months	Diphtheria-Tetanus-Whooping Cough Hepatitis B — or at 12 months Haemophilus Influenzae type b (Hib) (may be given depending on vaccine type) Polio Pneumococcal disease
12 months	Hepatitis B - or at 6 months Haemophilus Influenzae type b (Hib) Measles-Mumps-Rubella Meningococcal C disease
18 months	Chickenpox
4 years	Diphtheria-Tetanus-Whooping Cough Measles-Mumps-Rubella Polio
